
## Attend the Planting

### Tree Selection

The Springfield Parks Foundation is dedicated to preserving and restoring native vegetation within our parks. We have partnered with the Springfield Park District's Arborist to establish an approved tree list that meets this restoration criteria. You may choose your memorial tree from the list that follows. Trees from this list are compatible with and can be placed in any of the parks in our community. The Springfield Parks Foundation and the Park District's Arborist will coordinate the placement of your memorial tree and will make every effort to honor special requests.
